**Proargi-9+ Active WADA Compliance**

To Whom It May Concern:

The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) seeks to eliminate very specific natural and synthetic drug substances in certain quantities from high-level competition. WADA publishes a *Prohibited List* to define substances and methods prohibited at all times (in-and out-of-competition).

After careful review of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) *2013 prohibited substances list*, none of the ingredients in Proargi-9+ Active have been found to the best of our knowledge to violate the WADA compliance standards. As a result, this product can be a safe and beneficial addition to the diets of high-level competitors concerned with avoiding substances banned by WADA.

During manufacture, quality assurance procedures are followed to ensure that ProArgi-9+ Active is protected against adulteration, label ingredient claims are met, and that the finished product and ingredients, to the best of our knowledge, are free of athletic banned substances.

Composition of ingredients: Proargi-9+ Active

Proargi-9+ Active product code 74044 contains:

Pyridoxine HCl, Folic Acid, Cyanocobalamin, L-arginine, Quercetin (extract from *Sophora japonica* fruit), D-ribose, Citric Acid, Erythritol, Maltodextrin, Tropical Fruit flavor, Peach flavor, Natural Citrus Sweetener, anti-caking agent (silicon dioxide), Beet Root Juice concentrate (*Beta vulgaris*), and Stevia Leaf Extract (*Stevia rebaudiana*).

Each ingredient in the product listed above have been reviewed and are not found in the 2013 International Standard World Anti-Doping Code Prohibited List published by the World Anti-Doping Agency.

The product listed above is manufactured in a United States Food and Drug Administration (US FDA) current Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMP) compliant facility. US FDA cGMP regulations prevent the cross contamination of ingredients and materials through documented cleaning schedules and proper control measures in manufacturing. The products are also manufactured in a cGMP facility under the State of Utah Wholesome Food Act and The Utah Food Protection Rule. Furthermore, the products listed above are also manufactured in a NSF<sup>®</sup> cGMP compliant facility which is subject to a yearly review and audit as testified by the attached document. Finally, the products listed above are manufactured in an Australian Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) compliant facility. The TGA performs routine inspections and audits of the facility cGMP program. Adherence to cGMP regulations prevents the incidental cross contamination of food ingredients.


